Catherine Devaraj founded the school in 1989 with a mission to deliver quality English education to an almost entirely illiterate, tribal community.

Without Child-Link's support, these girls would have faced illiteracy and early marriage, devoid of choices regarding their own futures or beliefs.

Today, some of the girls that Child-Link have helped have become doctors, teachers and nurses, many with a strong faith and confidence in who they are.

**Meet Sheeba, a remarkable young lady, sponsored through Child-Link.**

The school celebrated a momentous achievement: attaining the highest marks in its A-level equivalent exams district-wide! Sheeba, captured in the image on the right alongside her overjoyous mother below, has been under Child-Link's sponsorship for the past seven years.



Her father's injury rendered him unable to work, leaving them unable to afford Sheeba's education. They belong to the most disadvantaged people group in the local society. Thanks to her outstanding exam results, Sheeba has embarked on a journey toward a degree in Accounting with a partial scholarship at Bishop Heber College in a nearby city.

Rama Bairavi, yet another Child-Link sponsored girl, came in second in the district.

These two girls topped the government exams from around 20,000 students in total. An achievement well worth celebrating and one which demonstrates what giving a girl a chance can mean and also what an effective school we have teamed up with.
